

# **NAIROBI TENTED CAMP**

NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK, KENYA

## LOCATION:

Deep within a riverine forest minutes from Jomo Kenyatta Airport, Wilson Airport and Nairobi City is a true wilderness experience. Visitors can arrive into Kenya and get 'straight under canvas' within 30 minutes of leaving the airport. Nairobi Tented Camp is an authentic tented camp in the heart of Nairobi National Park.

## **DESCRIPTION:**

It is the first accommodation of any sort to be allowed in this unique safari destination. There isn't anywhere else in the world like it; a wilderness escape where you can savour the thrill of camping in the heart of thick bushland right on the doorstep of Nairobi. With sweeping plains on one side and Nairobi city on the other, Nairobi National Park is a wildlife haven unlike any other, with virtually guaranteed sightings of rhino a reason in itself to visit, and Nairobi Tented Camp offers guests the opportunity to really get to know this unique destination and its wildlife. International visitors will leave Jomo Kenyatta airport and within ten minutes start their wildlife encounter, with the last 20 minutes of their short half an hour journey filled with the excitement of their first game drive in Kenya.

## FOOD AND BEVERAGE AMENTIES:

The meals at Nairobi Tented Camp are crafted to complement the authenticity of the safari experience. All meals are served on a set menu basis, with warming hearty breakfast in the morning, light invigorating lunches served under the shade of an olive tree and dinners of soufflés and tender beef fillet served under the star filled sky. Everything at Nairobi Tented Camp is homemade and cooked with special care and attention. If you have any special dietary requirements, please let us know at the time of booking. Ice cold drinks are available from the fully stocked bar in the central mess tent.

# **NUMBER OF ROOMS:**

The camp consists of nine guest tents each with accommodation for two people. One of these is raised on a platform overlooking the forest and is ideal for honeymooners.

# **ROOM DÉCOR:**

The tents are spacious and with an exclusive yet friendly feel. Tents are tastefully furnished with local material and comfortable pillows made from colourful fabrics have been used to add on to the exotic feel. The beds are comfortable and wrapped in cosy blankets and soft towels.

## **ROOM AMENITIES:**

Each tent contains a double /twin and single bed with bedside tables, torch, gas and kerosene lanterns, wardrobe for hanging your clothes, luggage rack, en-suite toilet with bucket shower and basin, writing desk with lamp, carpets of sheep skin rugs on the floor LED lighting Chairs and table on veranda for relaxing. Hot water bottles in each bed to chase the cold at night.

## **GENERAL FACILITIES:**

Low watt LED lighting in each of the tents runs off rechargeable batteries and solar panels, and for dining guests can enjoy the romance of candles and lanterns – a truly authentic tented camp experience. There are no electrical outlets in the guest tents and all battery charging is done in the manager's office. There is a library in the lounge area where guests can relax and unwind. The tents do not require mosquito nets around the beds as the tents are insect proof with screen windows and a zipped up door. Insect repellant towelettes are provided in the tents. Wi-Fi is available at the camp. Laundry can be done upon request. Fire and safety equipment are strategically placed in the camp.

#### **RECREATION ACTIVITIES:**

Morning game drives potentially filled with sightings of giraffes, buffaloes and leopards, evening game drives which offer a chance to catch that evasive moment where a lion might decide it's time to feast, backgammon games might be enjoyed or a good read can be found from one of the many books in the library. Visits to the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, Giraffe Centre, Karen Blixen Museum, Nairobi Museum, Kazuri Beads, Marula Studios, and Utamaduni can also be organised easily due to the unique location of the camp.

## **CLIMATE:**

The climate is warm and temperate in Nairobi. The temperature here averages 19.0 °C

#### **CONFERENCE FACILITIES:**

For very small groups, can be organized upon request, however no conferencing electronics available.
