

RHINO RIVER CAMP

ADJACENT TO THE MERU NATIONAL PARK

LOCATION: The Rhino River Camp is located on the western border of Meru National Park, Rhino River Camp is Located around 200 miles north-east of Nairobi on the banks of the gently flowing Kindani river. Access is possible by car on sealed tarmac road arriving at Meru park's main gate, or by scheduled or chartered flight landing inside the park with a (complimentary) 40-minute transfer to our camp – a scenic journey that often offers the visitor a first look at the area's big game! We are literally at the doors of the rhino sanctuary of Meru Park which is arguably its main attraction. The Kindani river itself, where our rooms are set, is as pristine as it gets.

How to get there: Rhino River Camp is located 360 km from Nairobi.

- By air: Air Kenya scheduled flights and charter from Nairobi Wilson airport (50mins) to Kinna airstrip and half-hour off-road drive safari.
- By car: 5/6 hrs drive from Nairobi along a tarmac road and access Meru NP from Murera Gate

DESCRIPTION:

Rhino River Camp is situated in 60 acres of privately owned wilderness right on the edge of the Meru National Park and it is an excellent base from where to explore Meru National Park, with opportunities to see all of Africa's "Big Five". Rhino River camp is situated in beautiful location by the entrance to the Rhino Sanctuary of the Meru National Park (Literally guaranteeing a rhino sighting on every game drive! The location and forest environment of Rhino River Camp lend the camp a strong, jungle atmosphere, enhanced by the constant background sound of the Kindani river's small waterfall. The very design of Rhino River Camp, contemporary with a hint of Africa, is pleasant without being intrusive.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE AMENTIES:

Though a full board option is available, a majority of guests' book the all-inclusive option that includes all meals, activities and drinks (gin, vodka, wine, beer, sodas, juice and mineral water). You will be pleasantly surprise you by the good selection of gourmet dishes, many with an Italian accent. Our food is praised by every single guest. It is refreshing, after a morning or an afternoon spent in the bush, knowing that you can expect a meal up to the highest standard. The camp caters for all dietary requirements and this will be required upon booking confirmation. All meals are served on a set menu basis, with warming hearty breakfast in the morning, light invigorating lunches and dinners served under the star filled sky. Indian cuisine is available on request. Guests can choose to eat on the terrace of their rooms, by the pool– the choice is entirely yours.

NUMBER OF ROOMS:

The camp has a total of 7 tents.

A further 02 tents are located away from the river, facing a natural forest for those that prefer to be away from the sound of Kindani Rivers running water.

02 of the river facing tents have their own private 'zen' area where you can meditate, re-read your favourite novel, or simply unwind.

ROOM DÉCOR:

Five of the tents are built out of sumptuous caramel canvas and sustainably grown wood, raised on platforms above the gently flowing Kindani River will turn your stay at Rhino River Camp into a quiet, exclusive experience. Each tent features a wide bedroom a bathroom, a wardrobe and it is surrounded by a lush riverine forest. The wooden platform is linked to an intimate Zen tent where guests can unwind after an exciting game drive.

ROOM AMENITIES:

Each tent contains a double bed with bedside tables, bedside LED lamps, torch, wardrobe for hanging your clothes, luggage rack, plug points for charging cameras and laptops, en-suite toilet with bucket shower and basin, writing desk with lamp, carpets on the floor, fan and table on veranda for relaxing.

SPECIAL FEATURE:

The 60-acre parcel of private land that the camp is on protects the last real riverine forests that re a prominent feature of the landscape of years gone. The quiet private setting of the camp offers the chance to connect with nature and to delight the senses in un-spoilt bush and forest. Whether it's watching the classic African wildlife, going on a bush hike or simply soaking up the savannah sun with a drink in the evening, Rhino River Camp offers endless opportunities for adventure and the **perfect space for relaxation**.

GENERAL FACILITIES:

The Camp is connected to the national power grid and electricity sockets are available throughout the camp. Solar water heaters are used to heat your water. The tents do not require mosquito nets around the beds as the tents are insect proof with screen windows and a zipped up door. Insect repellant towelettes are provided in the tents. Fire and safety equipment are strategically placed in the camp. Wifi is available from the main area and hand laundry on request, Rhino River Camp has a large central public area with a bar, lounge, and a library. It has a view over the river and the whole forest. The adjacent dining area is open from early to late. With no set meal times, and exclusive service, indulge your appetite and senses.

RECREATION ACTIVITIES:

- Game Drives: Meru National Park is home to an extraordinary array of wildlife. Our four-wheel drive vehicles and professional guides are at your disposal to explore the bush at your pace. Seen in their natural habitat, the animals of Meru afford the visitor a wonderful experience of African wilderness and raw, unspoilt nature, complemented by the beautiful landscapes visible at every turn. You are likely to see rhino, lion, cheetah, elephant, buffaloes, reticulated giraffes, and many more. Not to mention birdlife this in Meru is peculiarly diverse with over 600 species listed. Our guides are all members of the Kenya Professional Safari Guides Association.
- **Fishing:** Enjoy casting your fishing line along Rojewero and Tana rivers to catch the many edible species living in the park. You can "catch & release" or bring your fish to cook at the camp!
- **Bush Meals:** Ask us to arrange for a bush breakfast or a bush lunch. This will allow you to spend more time on your game drive not to mention the thrill and the pleasure of having a meal into the wilderness of Africa.
- Bush Walks: In our privately owned compound we have carved a few paths which
 will allow you to walk comfortably around our pristine environment on foot. The paths
 are specially selected to take you to where you are most likely to see unusual birds,
 and many other small creatures around camp. One hundred and eighty-nine different
 species of birds have been officially identified in the compound of the Camp alone.
 You can also leave the confines of the lodge and explore by foot nearby farms,
 villages and countryside.
- **Swimming Pool:** You can relax in our swimming pool near the Kindani River Which runs beside the Camp. Enjoy having a bath after the Game Drive while your children play and splash in the water. You can sunbath in one of the canvas chairs or relax under the shade of various tree surrounding the pool.
- Massages and beauty treatments: After a busy day of adventure in the bush, why
 not relax completely with a massage or a beauty treatment from our skilled
 masseuse? A break at Rhino River Camp is a break away from the stresses,
 deadlines and worries of a busy life back home, so take this opportunity to indulge
 yourself in the beautiful surroundings of Meru.
- **Library:** In the tents and in the main area there is a vast selection of "Africa" novels, essays and coffee table books for guests to enjoy freely.
